

Salish Sea Regatta Mooring & Shoreside Regulations September 6 – 8, 2024

The following are not permitted:

- 1. Discharge of effluent while moored.
- 2. Commercial or business activities.
- 3. Camping.
- 4. Water skiing, wake boarding, tubing or similar activities from the floats.
- 5. The leaving of garbage and/or recyclables.
- 6. Use or movement of firefighting equipment except in an emergency.
- 7. Discharge of firearms, air guns, slingshots, funnelators, or other weapons.
- 8. Smoking ashore. Violation of this rule by either a member or a guest will result in disqualification from the event.
- 9. Open fires at any time, however barbecuing is permitted at designated sites.
- 10. Boat washing activities, even if using your own water supply.

All boats must ensure:

- 1. The use of either holding tanks or onshore facilities.
- 2. Children wear life jackets on the floats unless they are competent swimmers.
- 3. Children are carefully supervised and specifically warned of the danger of hazardous cliffs.
- 4. Generators are not operated between 2200 hrs. and 0800 hrs.
- Use of sound equipment, power tools, musical instruments, or participation in noisy activities does not infringe on the quiet enjoyment of others, particularly between 2200 and 0800 hrs.
- 6. Dinghies, inflatables, jet skis, and personal watercraft are operated safely and in a courteous manner.
- 7. Boats must follow the instructions of the wharfinger on arrival, including where to raft alongside other boats.
